### FIELD TRIP TO NOCCALULA FALLS

Sunday, July 15 was a very special day for First Georgia Dowzers - we had our most successful field trip to date! Twelve saw Noccalula Falls: Anne Haliwell, Bill Hilmes, Trudi Dido, Ken Williams, Leah Schweitzer, Bill Phillips, Randall Carlson, his son Jessie Carlson, Brad Young, and two of Jessie's friends. Noccalula Falls is a Gasden, Alabama city park north of the central portion of Gasden. 3 years ago, Bill Phillips discovered the portal and noticed large scale erosion of the rocks; therefore this was a dual purpose visit: (a - dowsing) explore the intriguing portal and (b - geological) evaluate megaflood evidence.

## **Dowsing Exploration**

We were able to locate the portal easily, and it had not shifted during the 3 year interval. The geometry is fascinating - it is best described as a "convergent - divergent" pattern, with 8 widely spaced ley lines closely spaced at the center, and widely spaced in the surrounding area. This provides the 8 by 8 ley line criteria for a portal (64 intersections). The inner and outer pairs cross, while the other pairs splay outward.

## **Surprises**

We had several unexpected situations that made this trip even more fulfilling.

(1) Boxes: The portal had two "boxes" (closed loops). One 11 feet outside the edge, and a 24 foot box centrally located. It is believed these in some manner tune or control the portal.

(2) Lower Portal: The waterfall is greatly undercut, and Bill Phillips suggested that the portal was also accessible at this lower level (60-70 feet below the level of the park). Indeed, the lines were there - however it was an altogether different feel than the top portal. This one had wide lines (12-18 feet wide and no space between them, the central two making the L-rod rotate a revolution as it was measured; we deduced that it was a distinct portal.

(3) Masonic Monument: Local Masons had erected a most intriguing monument - a pyramid (a highly sloped one, not Egyptian proportions), altar, and 3 chairs. The chairs were different heights off the ground (the north chair being 3 steps up, east 2 steps, south 1 step), and the height of the chair back was proportional in the same way (north with a very high backrest, south only a foot), symbolizing the level of development of the officiating officers. The spacing of the pyramid, altar, and east chair was a golden ratio. These masons dowsed also - the two lines coming from the portal went through the pyramid and the altar!!

(4) Separation of detrimental energy: One aspect of portals is an energy that is harmful to human health, and affects the central cross section of the head (eyes, ears, sinuses, temporal lobes, ). Usually, this causes headaches within minutes if the portal is active. We stood within the portal for more than an hour without this deleterious effect! Then Anne found a spot that she could not tolerate to stand in (and caused headaches) - it was the innermost crossover point! This dangerous energy had been diverted to these points to allow people to be in the active region for extended times without harmful effects! This indicates advanced knowledge, and intentional design of the system - a masterful example of subtle energy engineering!

(5) energy spots or "time windows" found by Anne: These ran about 17 feet from the paved sidewalk, approximating the undercut below. Bill Phillips later noticed that the ley running through the altar seemed to align with these five positions.

Initial evidence indicates this portal is serving 2 functions - as an information portal (an access point of information, like a TV broadcast station), and an energy portal (like a fountain, spraying subtle energy into the environment). There is a high probability that it was a teleportation portal (dimensional doorway; one you can walk through) at one time, and subsequently shut down by the Indians when they left.

## **Geological evaluation**

Randall Carlson was invited on this trip to evaluate the profile of water erosion at the site. Nocalula falls rests at the upper point of a gorge that runs a couple of miles - however the stream bed has a gentle slope both upstream and downstream, indicating a collection of water and subsequent discharge into a rather normal flow pattern. Only near the gorge was

there significant (even catastrophic) erosion. Randall estimates water 100 feet deep or higher would be needed to carve such formations as we saw. Many geologists are too timid to ponder this level of flooding, however recent evidence has forced them to confront the catastrophic actions indicated by sites such as Noccalula Falls.

There is a softer rock layer that was eroded at a higher rate - and can be seen at the maximum incursion of the undercut (which lies at the boundary of the layers). The upper strata is a limestone of curious orange color, the lower strata apparently rich in quartz and highly fissured (making it susceptible to erosion). This combination produces deep gorges when tremendous volumes of water rapidly erode the soft rock and leave an overburden of poorly supported rock overhead.

The rubble now visible beneath the falls fell into place as it separated from the roof of the undercut ledge. It must be noted that what we see as the creek is not the bottom - there are dozens of feet of rubble, all across the canyon, that lie atop and obscure the true lowest extent of of erosion!

So what could have scoured the rocks at Gasden so severely? Randall has an initial analysis from topo maps that the current small stream we see now may have been a major river in the past, draining significantly more land than today, perhaps exiting from an extinct lake. Geological processes could have opened up additional drainage paths, weakening a once mighty river.

### **Allegory revisited**

The falls were named after Noccalula, an Indian Maiden facing a forced marriage and, rather than marry the brute selected for her, jumped to her death over the falls. Now, how many times have you heard this story - around the Southeast as well as other tribes across the country? Either there were huge numbers of suicidal Indian maidens (usually the daughter of a Chief), OR this was some sort of allegory about the site.... Could it have been: (a) an indication the earth energies are incompatible and were brought together (forced marriage), (b) that this allegory is used to indicate a double portal (one leading to higher consciousness, the other "taking a leap" into the underworld), (c) that "taking a leap" was stepping through a dimensional doorway (and disappearing from this reality), or (d) that it is somehow descriptive of the energy flow or some other action of the portal. This is a common Indian myth / legend and it will be interesting to solve this mystery.



### **DOWSING TIP**

A simple question we almost always forget to ask: Is this affecting me or my ability to dowse correctly? Many of the earth lines, entities, energy zones, food (allergies), or medications that we are evaluating with dowsing will destabilize us and adversely affect our ability to obtain correct answers. On the positive side, there are substances or energies that heighten your abilities!
