FUTURE MEETINGS

For June, Dr. Robert Robideau will speak on "Body Restoration Technique - new healing technology through electromagnetic - laser interface". DOWSING TIP

Vortex formation is an intrinsic behavior of subtle energies. Dowsters should be advised that subtle energies will swirl, twist, or spiral at every opportunity! The reason is based upon the expanded geometry that supports quantum mechanics - and without getting too technical, the currents have a dominant rotational component that is present - and is most noticeable at line crossings. When lines intersect, there will be a vortex present along the line of intersection. The lines are actually "curtains", partly underground and stretching upward a significant distance - therefore there is a vertical line of intersection of the two planes.

The vortex allows some of the flow within the line to cross over into our 3-D environment. There are minor rotations along the axis of each line, although these are usually not measured. And for the health dowsters: a smaller version of this effect comprises the chakras - and an even smaller version at acupuncture points. If you have not explored the rotational sideshow subtle energies play out for you, look for it the next time you do some dowsing!
