NEW FGD MEETING LOCATION

Sandy Springs Christian Church 301 Johnson Ferry Road At the intersection of Johnson Ferry and Abernathy Road.

<u>From North or South using GA 400</u>: Take Abernathy exit (first exit north of I-285), drive west 1.9 miles, turn right into Church parking lot just before the light at Johnson Ferry road.

<u>From North using Johnson Ferry Road</u>: Take Johnson Ferry road; Drive 1 mile south of the Chattahoochee River, turn left into the Church just before the traffic light at Abernathy road.

<u>From West using I-285</u>: Exit onto Riverside Drive; go north (left) 0.6 mile; turn right onto River Valley Road; drive 1.25 miles, turn left onto Johnson Ferry; and take the first driveway on the right into the Church.

<u>From East using I-285</u>: Exit onto Roswell Road (right); drive north 0.9 mile, turn left onto Johnson Ferry, drive 1 mile, turn right into the Church. (The first driveway past Abernathy.)

DOWSING TIP

Subtle energies behave differently than physical forces - including the concurrent existence of positive and negative polarity. Nonphysical patterns exist with their opposites without diminishing their strength. Physical energies cancel an opposing charge; only the difference is measured. Dowsing distinguishes the "active balance" (the presence and interplay of both factors) and measures it. Next time you measure a polarity (positive/negative, beneficial/detrimental, healthy/toxic,) measure the opposite and see if there is an active balance present.
