MEMBERS: SHARE YOUR FASCINATING KNOWLEDGE

One of the most important things we do at First Georgia Dowsers is to facilitate the sharing of information. This is a special and unique group that we get to share time with once a month - and LEARN! Submit information, experiences, and knowledge to maximize this process - we can use it in the newsletter, in a meeting, or during a field trip. In this spirit I present a

Dowsing tip: When you need to measure ley lines in inaccessible places (a lake, deep valley, very rough ground, thorn infested thickets) or over long distances (thousands of feet away) do it by optical sighting. Use the tip of your left finger to align with the target and hold the rod or pendulum in your right hand to get the reading! (This utilizes the left-receptive, right-emissive model.) For much improved resolution, a fishing pole with a small, brightly colored target affixed to the end may be used.
